20 information removed must remain available on the report maintained

21 in the authority's office.

22 <u>(h) A report made available on an Internet website under</u>

23 this section must be accessible on that website until the fifth

24 anniversary of the date the report is first made available.

- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 6 a report under Chapter 254, Election Code, that is required to be 7 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A report under 8 that chapter that is required to be filed before the effective date 9 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the report 10 is required to be filed, and the former law is continued in effect
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
