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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 254.0401, Election Code, is amended by
- amending Subsections (a-1) and (c) and adding Subsections (g), (h), 7
- and (i) to read as follows: 8
- (a-1) The county clerk of a county [with a population of 9
- 800,000 or more] shall make a report filed with the clerk by a 10
- 11 candidate, officeholder, or specific-purpose committee under this
- 12 subchapter [in connection with a county office or the office of
- county commissioner] available to the public on the county's 13
- 14 Internet website not later than the fifth business day after the
- date the report is received. 15
- The clerk of a municipality [with a population of 16
- 500,000 or more] shall make a report filed with the clerk by a 17
- candidate, officeholder, or specific-purpose committee under this 18
- subchapter [in connection with the office of mayor or member of the 19
- municipality's governing body available to the public on the 20
- 21 municipality's Internet website not later than the fifth business
- day after the date the report is received. 22
- 23 (g) The clerk or secretary of the governing body of a
- 24 political subdivision or, if the political subdivision has no clerk

- 1 or secretary, the governing body's presiding officer shall make a
- 2 report filed with the political subdivision by a candidate,
- 3 officeholder, or specific-purpose committee under this subchapter
- 4 available to the public on the political subdivision's Internet
- 5 website not later than the fifth business day after the date the
- 6 report is received.
- 7 (h) Before making a report available on the Internet as
- 8 required by Subsection (a-1), (c), or (g), the authority with whom
- 9 the report is filed may remove each portion, other than city, state,
- 10 and zip code, of the address of a person listed as having made a
- 11 political contribution to the person filing the report. The
- 12 address information removed must remain available on the report
- 13 maintained in the authority's office.
- 14 (i) A report made available on an Internet website under
- 15 this section must be accessible on that website until the fifth
- 16 <u>anniversary of the date the report is first made available.</u>
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 254.04011, Election Code, is repealed.
- 18 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 19 a report of political contributions and expenditures that is
- 20 required to be filed under Chapter 254, Election Code, on or after
- 21 the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
