(a) In this section, "institution of higher 9 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003. 10 11 (b) During the fall semester of each academic year, an 12 institution of higher education shall distribute by e-mail to each student enrolled at the institution information regarding women's 13 14 health programs administered by the Health and Human Services Commission, including information about: 15 16 (1) the eligibility requirements for those programs; 17 and 18 (2) the enrollment procedures for those programs, including a link to the Health and Human Services Commission's 19 Internet website that <u>hosts that enrollment information</u>. 20 21 SECTION 2. Section 51.9198, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning with the 2023 fall semester. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24

Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
