- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 182.054, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 182.054. EXCEPTIONS. This subchapter does not
- 8 prohibit a government-operated utility from disclosing personal
- 9 information in a customer's account record to:
- 10 (1) an official or employee of the state, a political
- 11 subdivision of the state, or the United States acting in an official
- 12 capacity;
- 13 (2) an employee of a utility acting in connection with
- 14 the employee's duties;
- 15 (3) a consumer reporting agency;
- 16 (4) a contractor or subcontractor approved by and
- 17 providing services to the utility, the state, a political
- 18 subdivision of the state, or the United States;
- 19 (5) a person for whom the customer has contractually
- 20 waived confidentiality for personal information; [or]
- 21 (6) another entity that provides water, wastewater,
- 22 sewer, gas, garbage, electricity, or drainage service for
- 23 compensation;
- 24 (7) another entity as necessary to facilitate the

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- 1 transition of customers among retail electric providers under
- 2 Section 40.053 or to comply with rules, guidelines, and procedures
- 3 <u>established by an independent organization certified under Section</u>
- 4 39.151; or
- 5 (8) a retail electric provider, as defined by Section
- 6 31.002(17).
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
