A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the disclosure of customer 2 by information government-operated utilities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 182.054, Utilities Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 Sec. 182.054. EXCEPTIONS. This 7 subchapter does not prohibit a government-operated utility from disclosing personal 8 information in a customer's account record to: 9 (1) an official or employee of the state, a political 10 11 subdivision of the state, or the United States acting in an official 12 capacity; 13 (2) an employee of a utility acting in connection with the employee's duties; 14 15 (3) a consumer reporting agency; 16 (4) a contractor or subcontractor approved by and providing services to the utility, the state, a political 17 subdivision of the state, or the United States; 18 (5) a person for whom the customer has contractually 19 20 waived confidentiality for personal information; [or] 21 (6) another entity that provides water, wastewater, 22 sewer, gas, garbage, electricity, or drainage service for 23 compensation; 24 (7) another entity as necessary to facilitate the

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transition of customers among retail electric providers under 1 2 Section 40.053 or to comply with rules, guidelines, and procedures established by an independent organization certified under Section 3 4 **39.151;** or 5 (8) a retail electric provider, as defined by Section 6 31.002(17). 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 11
