## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 772.0064, Government Code, is amended by
7	amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (n) and (o) to read
8	as follows:
9	(d) The task force is composed of the following members:
10	(1) the governor or the governor's designee;
11	(2) a representative of each state agency that has
12	duties relating to the prevention, investigation, or prosecution of
13	sexual assault or other sex offenses or provides services to
14	survivors, including:
15	(A) the office of the attorney general; [and]
16	(B) the Health and Human Services Commission; and
17	(C) the Department of Family and Protective
18	Services;
19	(3) the executive director of the Texas Commission on
20	Law Enforcement or the executive director's designee;
21	(4) the presiding officer of the Texas Forensic
22	Science Commission or the presiding officer's designee;
23	(5) the division director of the law enforcement

- 1 authority over the Crime Laboratory Service or the division
- 2 director's designee;
- 3 (6) the president of the Texas Association of Crime
- 4 Laboratory Directors or the president's designee;
- 5 (7) the president of the Texas District and County

- 7 (8) [the president of the Texas Society of
- 8 Pathologists or the president's designee;
- 9 [<del>(9)</del>] the president of the International Association
- 10 of Forensic Nurses Texas Chapter or the president's designee;
- 11 (9) (40) the president of the statewide
- 12 organization described by Section 264.409, Family Code, or the
- 13 president's designee;
- (10)  $[\frac{(11)}{(11)}]$  the president of the state sexual assault
- 15 coalition, as defined by Section 420.003, or the president's
- 16 designee;
- (11)  $[\frac{(12)}{}]$  a representative from a law enforcement
- 18 agency appointed by the steering committee described by Subsection
- 19 (c);
- (12)  $[\frac{(13)}{}]$  a sexual assault nurse examiner appointed
- 21 by the steering committee described by Subsection (c) to represent
- 22 the interests of health care facilities that perform sexual assault
- 23 forensic exams;
- 24 (13) an adult survivor of child sexual abuse or the
- 25 parent or guardian of a survivor of child sexual abuse;
- 26 (14) a survivor of adult sexual assault; and
- 27  $\underline{(15)}$  [ $\overline{(14)}$ ] other members considered appropriate by

- 1 the steering committee described by Subsection (c).
- 2 (n) A task force member who is not employed by a state agency
- 3 or an individual invited by the governor to participate in
- 4 scheduled task force meetings is entitled to:
- 5 (1) a per diem in the amount provided by the General
- 6 Appropriations Act for each day the member performs duties as a task
- 7 force member or the individual attends a task force meeting; and
- 8 (2) reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses
- 9 incurred in performing duties as a member or participant of the task
- 10 force, as applicable.
- 11 (o) Chapter 2110 does not apply to the composition or
- 12 <u>duration of the task force or to the designation of the task force's</u>
- 13 presiding officer.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 772.0064(m), Government Code, is
- 15 repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
