A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.167, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (b) and (d) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 7 (b-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), each [Each]
- 9 teacher for a prekindergarten program class must:
- 10 (1) be certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21; and
- 11 (2) have one of the following additional
- 12 qualifications:
- 13 (A) a Child Development Associate (CDA)
- 14 credential or another early childhood education credential
- 15 approved by the agency;
- 16 (B) certification offered through a training
- 17 center accredited by Association Montessori Internationale or
- 18 through the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher
- 19 Education;
- 20 (C) at least eight years' experience of teaching
- 21 in a nationally accredited child care program or a Texas Rising Star
- 22 Program;
- (D) be employed as a prekindergarten teacher in a
- 24 school district that has received approval from the commissioner

- 1 for the district's prekindergarten-specific instructional training
- 2 plan that the teacher uses in the teacher's prekindergarten
- 3 classroom; or
- 4 (E) an equivalent qualification.
- 5 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), each teacher for a
- 6 prekindergarten class provided by an entity with which a school
- 7 district contracts to provide a prekindergarten program must:
- 8 <u>(1) be supervised by a person who meets the</u>
- 9 requirements under Subsection (b); and
- 10 (2) have one of the qualifications described by
- 11 Subsection (b)(2).
- 12 <u>(b-2)</u> A person who supervises a prekindergarten teacher as
- 13 described by Subsection (b-1) may supervise multiple
- 14 prekindergarten classes.
- 15 (d) A school district or an entity with which the district
- 16 contracts to provide a prekindergarten program must attempt to
- 17 maintain an average ratio in any prekindergarten program class of
- 18 not less than one qualified [certified] teacher or teacher's aide
- 19 for each 11 students.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
