- 5 SECTION 1. Section 253.035(d), Election Code, is amended to

- In this section, "personal use" means a use that 7
- primarily furthers individual or family purposes not connected with 8
- 9 the performance of duties or activities as a candidate for or holder
- of a public office. The term does not include: 10
- 11 (1) payments made to defray ordinary and necessary
- 12 expenses incurred in connection with activities as a candidate or
- in connection with the performance of duties or activities as a 13
- 14 public officeholder, including payment of:
- (A) rent, utility, and other reasonable housing 15
- 16 or household expenses incurred in maintaining a residence in Travis
- County by members of the legislature who do not ordinarily reside in 17
- Travis County, but excluding payments prohibited under Section 18
- 253.038; or 19
- 20 (B) child-care expenses for a child of the
- 21 candidate or officeholder made in accordance with Section 253.0352;
- 22 or
- 23 (2) payments of federal income taxes due on interest
- 24 and other income earned on political contributions.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 253, Election Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 253.0352 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 253.0352. CHILD-CARE EXPENSES. A candidate or an
- 4 officeholder may use political contributions to pay for child-care
- 5 expenses incurred for a child of the candidate or officeholder,
- 6 including payment to a family member other than the child's parent,
- 7 legal guardian, or conservator.
- 8 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 payment of a child-care expense incurred by a candidate or
- 10 officeholder on or after the effective date of this Act. The
- 11 payment of a child-care expense incurred by a candidate or
- 12 officeholder before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 13 the law in effect on the date the payment was made, and the former
- 14 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
