## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the issuance of a standard permit for the emission of
3	air contaminants from a facility providing material for a public
4	work project.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 382.069 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 382.069. STANDARD PERMIT FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC WORK
9	PROJECTS. (a) In this section, "public work project" means a
10	project to construct, alter, or repair a civil engineering project,
11	including a road, street, bridge, underground utility, water supply
12	project, water plant, wastewater plant, or airport runway or
13	taxiway, under a contract entered into by a governmental entity
14	under Chapter 2269, Government Code.
15	(b) The commission shall issue a standard permit, if the
16	commission finds that the permit is enforceable, for a facility
17	that:
18	(1) is dedicated solely to the provision of material
19	for a public work project conducted under:
20	(A) a single contract; or
21	(B) one of multiple contracts for related project
22	segments by the same contractor;
23	(2) is not covered by an individual permit;
24	(3) is located in or contiguous to the right-of-way of

- 1 a public work project;
- 2 (4) can adequately monitor compliance with the terms
- 3 of the standard permit; and
- 4 (5) will use control technology at least as effective
- 5 as that described in Section 382.0518(b).
- 6 (c) The commission shall publish notice of a standard permit
- 7 proposed under this section in the Texas Register and in one or more
- 8 statewide or regional newspapers designated by the commission that
- 9 will, in the commission's judgment, provide reasonable notice
- 10 throughout the state. The notice must include an invitation for
- 11 written comments by the public to the commission regarding the
- 12 proposed standard permit and must be published not later than the
- 13 30th day before the date the commission issues the standard permit.
- 14 (d) The commission may hold a public meeting to provide an
- 15 additional opportunity for public comment. The commission shall
- 16 give notice of a public meeting under this subsection as part of the
- 17 notice described in Subsection (c) not later than the 30th day
- 18 before the date of the meeting.
- 19 (e) The commission by rule shall establish procedures for
- 20 the amendment of a standard permit and for the issuance and
- 21 revocation of an authorization to use a standard permit. The
- 22 procedures must:
- 23 (1) provide that an applicant may obtain an
- 24 authorization to use the standard permit issued under this section
- 25 for a facility by submitting to the commission a written notice of
- 26 intent to use the permit;
- 27 (2) specify the deadline for submitting and the

- 1 <u>information required to be included in a notice</u> of intent under
- 2 Subdivision (1); and
- 3 (3) authorize an applicant to specify a date or period
- 4 of time after the commission receives the notice of intent under
- 5 Subdivision (1) on which the emission of air contaminants from the
- 6 facility may begin unless the executive director notifies the
- 7 applicant that the facility is not authorized to use the standard
- 8 permit.
- 9 (f) A facility authorized to use a standard permit issued
- 10 under this section shall comply with an amendment to the standard
- 11 permit beginning on the date the facility's authorization to use
- 12 the permit is renewed or the date the commission otherwise
- 13 provides. Before the date the facility is required to comply with
- 14 the amendment, the standard permit, as it read before the
- 15 <u>amendment</u>, applies to the facility.
- 16 (g) A standard permit issued under this section must:
- 17 (1) provide that an operator of a facility authorized
- 18 to use the standard permit may use the standard permit for the
- 19 duration of the public work project, unless the executive director
- 20 notifies the operator that the facility is not authorized to use the
- 21 standard permit;
- 22 (2) require an authorization to use a standard permit
- 23 <u>issued under this section to terminate on the date the public work</u>
- 24 project is completed;
- 25 (3) require an operator of a facility authorized to
- 26 use a standard permit issued under this section to notify the
- 27 commission of the operator's intent to cease operations by

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- 1 submitting a written notice of termination to the commission; and
- 2 (4) specify the deadline for submitting and the
- 3 <u>information to be included in a notice of termination under</u>
- 4 Subdivision (3).
- 5 (h) Sections 382.0516 and 382.056 do not apply to an
- 6 application for an authorization to use a standard permit issued
- 7 under this section.
- 8 <u>(i)</u> The issuance or amendment of a standard permit or the
- 9 issuance, renewal, or revocation of an authorization to use a
- 10 standard permit is not subject to Chapter 2001, Government Code.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
