- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 13.0442 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.0442. LATE PAYMENT FEES CHARGED BY MUNICIPALITY.
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of a resolution or ordinance, a
- 9 customer charged a fee that violates Section 13.089 may appeal the
- 10 charge by filing a petition with the utility commission.
- 11 (b) The utility commission shall hear the appeal de novo,
- 12 and the municipality charging the fee has the burden of proof to
- 13 establish that the fee complies with Section 13.089. The utility
- 14 commission shall set the fees to be charged by the municipality in
- 15 accordance with Section 13.089.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
- 17 by adding Section 13.089 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 13.089. LATE PAYMENT FEES CHARGED BY MUNICIPALITY.
- 19 (a) A municipality may not charge a late payment fee that is more
- 20 than the greater of:
- 21 (1) \$5; or
- 22 (2) two percent of the amount past due, not to exceed
- 23 \$500.
- 24 (b) A late payment penalty period may not begin before the

- 1 30th day after the date the municipality mails or transmits
- 2 <u>electronically the customer's bill.</u>
- 3 (c) A late payment penalty period must end on the date the
- 4 customer pays all past due amounts to the municipality.
- 5 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 a fee charged on or after the effective date of this Act. A fee
- 7 charged before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 8 in effect on the date the fee was charged, and the former law is
- 9 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
