17	(3) "Retired judicial officer" means:
18	(A) a visiting judge appointed to serve as the
19	judge of a constitutional county court, a statutory county court,
20	or a statutory probate court [under Section 26.023 or 26.024];
21	(B) a senior judge designated under Section
22	75.001 or a judicial officer as designated or defined by Section
23	75.001, 831.001, or 836.001; or

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 5 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 7 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 8 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 9 before that date.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
