A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to voting by a voter unable to enter a polling place. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 64.009(a), Election Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 (a) On [If a voter is physically unable to enter the polling 7 place without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring the voter's health, on] the voter's request, an election officer shall 8 9 deliver a ballot to the voter at the polling place entrance or curb 10 if the voter: 11 (1) is physically unable to enter the polling place 12 without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring the voter's 13 health; 14 (2) has legal custody of a child younger than 12 years of age and entering the polling place would require leaving the 15 16 child without adequate supervision; or (3) is the primary caretaker of a person who is unable 17 to care for themselves and entering the polling place would require 18 leaving the person without adequate supervision. 19 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
