5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 67.04 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 67.04. COMPUTER SCIENCE EDUCATION CAPACITY PROMOTION
9	PROGRAM. (a) Using appropriated funds, the University of Texas at
10	Austin shall design, develop and implement a program connecting
11	local education agencies and institution of higher education with
12	evidence-based and accredited computer science professional
13	development resources provided by institutions of higher
14	education, nonprofit organizations, or other accredited providers.
15	(b) The program shall direct particular focus on public
16	school campuses that lack a certified computer science educator as
17	well as other underserved geographic locations and demographic
18	<pre>communities.</pre>
19	(c) Program funds may be used:
20	(1) to recruit new educators to the field of computer
21	science education by providing continued professional development
22	for existing and aspiring educators and certification stipends for
23	newly certified educators; and
24	(2) to provide stipends to educators who gain new

- 1 skills through professional development or successfully achieve an
- 2 <u>accredited</u> or <u>evidence-based</u> computer <u>science</u> <u>education</u>
- 3 <u>certification</u>.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
