A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to establishing the food systems office to promote food

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 2, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Chapter 22 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 22. FOOD SECURITY
- 8 Sec. 22.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "office" means
- 9 the food systems office within the department.
- Sec. 22.002. FOOD SYSTEMS OFFICE. (a) The food systems
- 11 office is established within the department.
- 12 (b) The office shall develop programs that support food
- 13 access and food security for Texas residents. The office shall
- 14 encourage and coordinate food security planning in this state for:
- 15 (1) establishing more localized food markets through
- 16 measures such as connecting local schools, retailers, and
- 17 distributors to local producers and collaborating with local
- 18 stakeholders to expand food delivery areas and providing buying
- 19 <u>support to small retailers;</u>
- 20 (2) creating streamlined and consolidated application
- 21 processes for multiple programs through a clearinghouse for public
- 22 assistance programs, farmer and distribution support programs,
- 23 opportunities for retail development, and food access business
- 24 <u>development information and resources;</u>

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- (3) establishing a communication network of local,

 state, federal non-governmental, and for-profit entities and

 programs operating in and relating to the food system in this state;

 (4) assisting farmers in contributing to food security

 such as by developing and providing information and resources

 regarding local food production and food markets;
- 6 regarding local food production and food markets;

 7 (5) collecting and monitoring information, such as

 8 local poverty rates and measures of food access, to identify food

 9 deserts and other communities or populations experiencing food

 10 insecurity and to assist and coordinate applications for relevant

 11 federal and state benefits; and
- 12 (6) focusing on community empowerment and resiliency
 13 to ensure the office is providing individuals with food access
 14 support.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
