A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the procedures for transferring certain cases and 3 proceedings between courts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 33.101, Estates Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

Sec. 33.101. TRANSFER TO OTHER COUNTY IN WHICH VENUE IS 7 PROPER. If probate proceedings involving the same estate are 8 9 commenced in more than one county and the court making a determination of venue as provided by Section 33.053 determines 10 11 that venue is proper in another county, the court clerk shall 12 transmit the file for the proceeding in accordance with the procedures provided by Section 33.105 [make and retain a copy of the 13 14 entire file in the case and transmit the original file in electronic or paper form] to the court in the county in which venue is proper. 15 The court to which the file is transmitted shall conduct the 16 proceeding in the same manner as if the proceeding had originally 17 been commenced in that county. 18

SECTION 2. Section 33.102(a), Estates Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) If it appears to the court at any time before the final order in a probate proceeding is rendered that the court does not have priority of venue over the proceeding, the court shall, on the application of an interested person, transfer the proceeding to the

proper county by transmitting the file for the proceeding in 1 accordance with the procedures provided by Section 33.105 to the 2 proper court in that county [in electronic or paper form: 3 4 [(1) the original file in the case; and 5 [(2) certified copies of all entries that have been made in the judge's probate docket in the proceeding]. 6 7 SECTION 3. Section 33.103(b), Estates Code, is amended to 8 read as follows: 9 (b) The clerk of the court from which the probate proceeding described by Subsection (a) is transferred shall transmit the file 10 for the proceeding in accordance with the procedures provided by 11 12 Section 33.105 to the court to which the proceeding is transferred[+ 13 14 [(1) the original file in the proceeding; and [(2) a certified copy of the index]. 15 16 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 33, Estates Code, is 17 amended by adding Section 33.105 to read as follows: Sec. 33.105. TRANSFER OF PROBATE PROCEEDING RECORD. (a) If 18 a probate proceeding is transferred to a court in another county 19 under this chapter, the clerk of the transferring court shall send 20 to the clerk of the court to which the proceeding is transferred, 21 using the electronic filing system established under Section 22 23 72.031, Government Code: 24 (1) a transfer certificate and index of transferred 25 documents; 26 (2) a copy of each final order; (3) a copy of the order of transfer signed by the 27

No. 2893 1 transferring court; 2 (4) a copy of the original papers filed in the 3 transferring court, including a copy of any will; 4 (5) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of 5 transferred documents from each previous transfer; and 6 (6) a bill of any costs accrued in the transferring 7 court. 8 (b) The clerk of the transferring court shall use the standardized transfer certificate and index of transferred 9 documents form developed by the Office of Court Administration of 10 the Texas Judicial System under Section 72.037, Government Code, 11 12 when transferring a proceeding under this section. (c) The clerk of the transferring court shall keep a copy of 13 14 the documents transferred under Subsection (a). 15 (d) The clerk of the court to which the proceeding is transferred shall: 16 17 (1) accept documents transferred under Subsection 18 (a); 19 (2) docket the proceeding; and (3) notify, using the electronic filing system 20 established under Section 72.031, Government Code, all parties to 21 the proceeding, the clerk of the transferring court, and, if 22 appropriate, the transferring court's local registry that the 23 24 proceeding has been docketed. (e) The clerk of the transferee court shall physically or 25 26 electronically mark or stamp the transfer certificate and index of transferred documents to evidence the date and time of acceptance 27

No. 2893 under Subsection (d) but may not physically or electronically mark 1 or stamp any other document transferred under Subsection (a). 2 (f) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring 3 courts may each produce under Chapter 51, Government Code, 4 5 certified or uncertified copies of documents transferred under Subsection (a) but must include a copy of the transfer certificate 6 7 and index of transferred documents with each document produced. (g) Sections 80.001 and 80.002, Government Code, do not 8 apply to the transfer of documents under this section. 9 The clerk of the transferring court shall deliver the 10 (h) original will to the clerk of the transferee court by: 11 12 (1) registered or certified mail, return receipt 13 requested; 14 (2) common or contract carrier, with proof of delivery 15 receipt; or (3) designated delivery service, as defined by 26 16 17 U.S.C. Section 7502(f)(2), with proof of delivery receipt. (i) The party requesting the transfer shall pay the cost of 18 19 delivery under Subsection (h). SECTION 5. Section 1023.006, Estates Code, is amended to 20 read as follows: 21 Sec. 1023.006. TRANSFER OF RECORD. (a) Not later than the 22 10th working day after the date [When] an order of transfer is 23 24 signed [made] under Section 1023.005, the clerk shall record any unrecorded papers of the guardianship required to be recorded. On 25 26 payment of the clerk's fee, the clerk shall send, using the electronic filing system established under Section 72.031, 27

Government Code, [transmit in electronic or paper form] to the 1 county clerk of the county to which the guardianship was ordered 2 3 transferred: 4 (1) a transfer certificate and index of transferred 5 documents [the case file of the guardianship proceedings]; [and] 6 (2) a copy of each final order; 7 (3) a copy of the order of transfer signed by the 8 transferring court; 9 (4) a copy of the original papers filed in the 10 transferring court; (5) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of 11 12 transferred documents from each previous transfer; and (6) a bill of any costs accrued in the transferring 13 court [a certified copy of the index of the guardianship records]. 14 15 (b) The clerk of the transferring court shall use the standardized transfer certificate and index of transferred 16 17 documents form developed by the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System under Section 72.037, Government Code, 18 when transferring a proceeding under this section. 19 (c) The clerk of the transferring court shall keep a copy of 20 the documents transferred under Subsection (a). 21 22 (d) The clerk of the court to which the proceeding is 23 transferred shall: 24 (1) accept documents transferred under Subsection 25 (a); 26 (2) docket the suit; and 27 (3) notify, using the electronic filing system

2	clerk of the transferring court, and, if appropriate, the
3	transferring court's local registry that the suit has been
4	docketed.
5	(e) The clerk of the transferee court shall physically or
6	electronically mark or stamp the transfer certificate and index of
7	transferred documents to evidence the date and time of acceptance
8	under Subsection (d), but may not physically or electronically mark
9	or stamp any other document transferred under Subsection (a).
10	(f) The clerk of the transferring court shall send a
11	certified copy of the order directing payments to the transferee
12	court to:
13	(1) any party affected by the order and, if
14	appropriate, to the local registry of the transferee court using
15	the electronic filing system established under Section 72.031,
16	Government Code; and
17	(2) an employer affected by the order electronically
18	or by first class mail.
19	(g) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring
20	courts may each produce under Chapter 51, Government Code,
21	certified or uncertified copies of documents transferred under
22	Subsection (a) but must include a copy of the transfer certificate
23	and index of transferred documents with each document produced.
24	(h) Sections 80.001 and 80.002, Government Code, do not
25	apply to the transfer of documents under this section.
26	SECTION 6. Section 1023.007, Estates Code, is amended to
27	read as follows:

Sec. 1023.007. TRANSFER EFFECTIVE. The order transferring 1 a guardianship does not take effect until the clerk of the court to 2 which the proceeding is transferred accepts and dockets the case 3 record under Section 1023.006[+ 4 [(1) the case file and a certified copy of the index 5 required by Section 1023.006 are filed in electronic or paper form 6 in the office of the county clerk of the county to which the 7 8 quardianship was ordered transferred; and 9 [(2) a certificate under the clerk's official seal and reporting the filing of the case file and a certified copy of the 10 index is filed in electronic or paper form in the court ordering the 11 transfer by the county clerk of the county to which the guardianship 12 was ordered transferred]. 13 SECTION 7. Sections 155.207(a), (b), and (e), Family Code, 14 15 are amended to read as follows: (a) Not later than the 10th working day after the date an 16 17 order of transfer is signed, the clerk of the court transferring a proceeding shall send, using the electronic filing system 18 established under Section 72.031, Government Code, to the proper 19 court [in the county] to which transfer is being made: 20 (1) a transfer certificate and index of transferred 21 22 documents; a copy of each final order; 23 (2) 24 (3) a copy of the order of transfer signed by the 25 transferring court; (4) a copy of the original papers filed 26 in the 27 transferring court;

(5) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of
 transferred documents from each previous transfer; and

3 (6) a bill of any costs that have accrued in the 4 transferring court.

5 (b) The clerk of the transferring court shall keep a copy of 6 <u>the documents transferred under Subsection (a)</u> [transferred 7 <u>pleadings</u>].

8 (e) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring 9 courts may each produce under Chapter 51, Government Code, 10 certified or uncertified copies of documents <u>transferred under</u> 11 <u>Subsection (a) and must</u> [filed in a case transferred under this 12 section, but shall also] include a copy of the transfer certificate 13 and index of transferred documents with each document produced.

14 SECTION 8. Section 51.3071, Government Code, is amended by 15 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read 16 as follows:

(a) If a case is transferred from a district court to a <u>constitutional or statutory</u> county court <u>or another district court</u>, the clerk of the <u>transferring</u> [district] court shall send to the [county] clerk <u>of the court to which the case is transferred</u>, using the electronic filing system established under Section 72.031:

(1) a transfer certificate and index of transferreddocuments;

24 (2) a copy of the original papers filed in the25 transferring court;

26 (3) a copy of the order of transfer signed by the27 transferring court;

(4) a copy of each final order; 1 2 (5) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of transferred documents from each previous transfer; and 3 4 (6) a bill of any costs that have accrued in the 5 transferring court. 6 (f) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring 7 courts may each produce, under this chapter, certified or 8 uncertified copies of documents transferred under Subsection (a) and must include a copy of the transfer certificate and index of 9 transferred documents with each document produced. 10 (g) This section applies regardless of whether the 11 12 transferee court and the transferring court are in the same or different counties. 13 SECTION 9. Section 51.403, Government Code, is amended by 14 15 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows: 16 17 (a) If a case is transferred from a county court to a district court or a statutory county court or a county court of 18 another county, the clerk of the transferring [county] court shall 19 send to the [district] clerk of the court to which the case is 20 transferred, using the electronic filing system established under 21 22 Section 72.031: a transfer certificate and index of transferred 23 (1)24 documents; 25 (2) a copy of the original papers filed in the 26 transferring court; (3) a copy of the order of transfer signed by the 27

1 transferring court;

(4) a copy of each final order;

3 (5) a copy of the transfer certificate and index of4 transferred documents from each previous transfer; and

5 (6) a bill of any costs that have accrued in the 6 transferring court.

7 <u>(d) The clerks of both the transferee and transferring</u> 8 courts may each produce, under this chapter, certified or 9 uncertified copies of documents transferred under Subsection (a) 10 and must include a copy of the transfer certificate and index of 11 transferred documents with each document produced.

12 <u>(e) This section applies regardless of whether the</u> 13 <u>transferee court and the transferring court are in the same or</u> 14 <u>different counties.</u>

15 SECTION 10. Section 72.037(a), Government Code, is amended 16 to read as follows:

(a) The office shall develop and make available a
standardized transfer certificate and an index of transferred
documents form to be used for the transfer of cases and proceedings
under <u>Sections 33.105 and 1023.006</u>, Estates Code, Section 155.207,
Family Code, and Sections 51.3071 and 51.403 of this code.

SECTION 11. Section 33.103(c), Estates Code, is repealed.

23 SECTION 12. As soon as practicable after the effective date 24 of this Act, the Office of Court Administration of the Texas 25 Judicial System shall adopt rules and develop and make available 26 all forms and materials required by Section 72.037, Government 27 Code, as amended by this Act.

1 SECTION 13. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
