## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the definition of preventable death of a child.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 264.501(8), Family Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	(8) "Preventable death" means a death that may have
7	been prevented by reasonable medical, social, legal,
8	psychological, or educational intervention. The term includes the
9	death of a child from:
10	(A) intentional or unintentional injuries;
11	(B) medical neglect;
12	(C) lack of access to medical care;
13	(D) neglect and reckless conduct, including
14	failure to supervise and failure to seek medical care; [and]
15	(E) premature birth associated with any factor
16	described by Paragraphs (A) through (D); and
17	(F) suicide.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
