## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT
relating to quarantine leave for certain public safety employees.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Chapter 607, Government Code, is amended by
adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
SUBCHAPTER D. QUARANTINE LEAVE FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES
Sec. 607.151. DEFINITIONS. (a) In this subchapter:
(1) "Detention officer" means an individual employed
by the state to ensure the safekeeping of prisoners and the security
of a state penal institution in this state.
(2) "Emergency medical technician" means an
individual who is:
(A) certified as an emergency medical technician
under Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code; and
(B) employed by the state.
(3) "Firefighter" means a paid employee of the state
who:
(A) holds a position that requires substantial
knowledge of firefighting;
(B) has met the requirements for certification by
the Texas Commission on Fire Protection under Chapter 419; and
(C) performs a function listed in Section
143.003(4)(A), Local Government Code.

- 2 (5) "Ordered to quarantine or isolate" means any
- 3 circumstance in which a person is not permitted to continue working
- 4 due to:
- 5 (A) a written or verbal directive by a health
- 6 authority or the employee's supervisor ordering the person to
- 7 refrain from reporting to duty after displaying symptoms of a
- 8 communicable disease; or
- 9 (B) a written or verbal directive by a health
- 10 authority or the employee's supervisor ordering the person to
- 11 refrain from reporting to duty after being exposed to a
- 12 communicable disease that is a presumptive illness under this
- 13 chapter.
- 14 (6) "Peace officer" means an individual described by
- 15 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, who is elected for,
- 16 employed by, or appointed by the state.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding Section 607.001, in this subchapter,
- 18 "public safety employee" means a detention officer, emergency
- 19 medical technician, firefighter, or peace officer.

- 21 SAFETY EMPLOYEES. (a) A state agency that employs public safety
- 22 <u>employees shall develop and implement a paid quarantine leave</u>
- 23 policy for public safety employees who are ordered to quarantine or
- 24 isolate.
- 25 (b) A paid quarantine leave policy must provide that a
- 26 public safety employee ordered to quarantine or isolate receive:
- 27 (1) all employment benefits and compensation,

- 1 including leave accrual, pension benefits, and health benefit plan
- 2 benefits for the duration of the leave; and
- 3 (2) reimbursement for reasonable costs related to the
- 4 quarantine, including lodging, medical, and transportation.
- 5 (c) The state agency may not reduce a public safety
- 6 employee's sick leave balance, vacation leave balance, or other
- 7 paid leave balance in connection with paid quarantine leave taken
- 8 in accordance with a policy adopted under this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
