- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 272.001, Business &
- 6 Commerce Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 272.001. VOIDABLE CONTRACT <u>PROVISIONS</u> [PROVISION].
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 272.001, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) If a construction contract contains a provision that
- 11 allows a party to the contract to wholly or partly withhold payment
- 12 owed under one contract to satisfy a claim or damages alleged under
- 13 another contract, that provision is voidable by the party whose
- 14 payment may be withheld under the provision.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 28.003, Property Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 17 <u>(c)</u> For purposes of this section, a good faith dispute does
- 18 not include a dispute relating to a contract, work order,
- 19 contractual arrangement, or any other agreement between the parties
- 20 that is not related to the contract for construction under which
- 21 payment is requested or required.
- SECTION 4. Section 162.031, Property Code, is amended by
- 23 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 24 (a-1) A trustee who retains or otherwise diverts trust funds

- 2 construction contract other than the contract in connection with

- 4 or direction of the trustee has misapplied the trust funds.
- 5 SECTION 5. Subchapter B, Chapter 162, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 162.034 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 162.034. ATTORNEY'S FEES. The court may award costs</u>
- 8 and reasonable attorney's fees in an action brought under this
- 9 subchapter.
- 10 SECTION 6. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 11 section, the changes in law made by this Act apply only to a
- 12 contract that is entered into on or after the effective date of this
- 13 Act.
- 14 (b) Section 162.034, Property Code, as added by this Act,
- 15 applies only to an action commenced on or after the effective date
- 16 of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
