H.B. No. 2957

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to periodic occupational cancer screenings for 3 firefighters. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended 5 by adding Section 180.010 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 180.010. OCCUPATIONAL CANCER SCREENING FOR FIREFIGHTERS. (a) In this section, "firefighter" means an 8 individual defined as fire protection personnel under Section 9 419.021, Government Code. 10 (b) A political subdivision that employs firefighters shall 11 12 offer an occupational cancer screening to each firefighter at no cost to the firefighter in the seventh year of the firefighter's 13 employment, and once every three years following the initial 14 15 screening. (c) The occupational cancer screening must be confidential 16 and test for each type of cancer, including: 17 18 (1) prostate cancer, if applicable; (2) lung cancer; and 19 20 (3) brain cancer.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
