## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 36.145 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 36.145. REQUIRED JURY INSTRUCTION ON CRIMINAL
- 8 CONSPIRACY IN CERTAIN CASES. During the trial of a case in which
- 9 the defendant is tried as a conspirator under Section 7.02(b),
- 10 Penal Code, the judge shall include in the court's charge under
- 11 Article 36.14 the following statement:
- 12 <u>"A criminal conspiracy is an agreement between two or more</u>
- 13 persons, with intent that a felony be committed, that they, or one
- 14 or more of them, engage in conduct that would constitute the
- 15 offense, and one or more of them perform an overt act in pursuance
- 16 of the agreement. An agreement constituting a conspiracy may be
- 17 inferred from acts of the parties."
- SECTION 2. Article 36.145, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 19 added by this Act, applies only to a trial that begins on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the alleged
- 21 offense was committed before, on, or after that date.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
