8	(a) In this section:
9	(1) "Day-care center" has the meaning assigned by
10	Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
11	(2) "Public property" includes a street, highway,
12	alley, public park, or sidewalk.
13	(3) "School" means a private or public elementary or
14	secondary school.
15	(4) "School or day-care center property" means:
16	(A) all land and buildings owned or leased by a
17	<pre>public school or day-care center; and</pre>
18	(B) any grounds or buildings used by a school or
19	day-care center for an assembly or other school-sponsored activity.
20	(b) A person commits an offense if the person:
21	(1) enters or remains on:
22	(A) school or day-care center property; or
23	(B) public property located within 250 feet of
24	school or day-care center property:

- 1 (2) poses a substantial risk of harm to any person or
- 2 behaves in a manner that is inappropriate for a school or day-care
- 3 center setting; and
- 4 (3) received a request to depart by an administrator
- 5 or security personnel officer employed by the school or day-care
- 6 center and failed to depart.
- 7 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 8 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 9 also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
- 10 actor may be prosecuted under either section or both sections.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
