- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2262.051(j), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (j) For a procurement in an amount that exceeds \$20 million
- 8 [other than a contract entered into by the comptroller under
- 9 Section 2155.061], the guide must require a state agency to notify
- 10 interested parties at least two months before the date the agency
- 11 issues the solicitation for the procurement <u>unless the procurement</u>
- 12 <u>is for:</u>
- (1) a contract entered into by the comptroller under
- 14 Section 2155.061; or
- 15 (2) a contract for services necessary to respond to a
- 16 natural disaster.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 a contract for which a state agency first advertises or otherwise
- 19 solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications on or after the
- 20 effective date of this Act. A contract for which a state agency
- 21 first advertised or otherwise solicited bids, proposals, offers, or
- 22 qualifications before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 23 when the first advertisement or solicitation was given, and the
- 24 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
