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H.B. No. 3033

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to attorney general decisions under the public information 3 law.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 552.306, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 7 follows:

(a) Except as provided by Section 552.011, the attorney 8 9 general shall promptly render a decision requested under this subchapter, consistent with the standards of due process, 10 11 determining whether the requested information is within one of the exceptions of Subchapter C. The attorney general shall render the 12 decision not later than the 30th [45th] business day after the date 13 14 the attorney general received the request for a decision. [If the attorney general is unable to issue the decision within the 45-day 15 16 period, the attorney general may extend the period for issuing the decision by an additional 10 business days by informing the 17 governmental body and the requestor, during the original 45-day 18 period, of the reason for the delay.] 19

20 (c) A governmental body shall as soon as practicable but not 21 later than the 15th day after the date a decision is issued:

22 (1) produce the information subject to the decision
 23 that is required to be produced; or

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(2) notify in writing the person who requested the

information that the governmental body is withholding the 1 information as authorized by the decision. 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 552, Government Code, is 3 amended by adding Section 552.310 to read as follows: 4 5 Sec. 552.310. SEARCHABLE DATABASE. (a) The office of the attorney general shall make available on the office's Internet 6 7 website an easily accessible and searchable database consisting of: 8 (1) each request for an attorney general decision made under this subchapter; and 9 10 (2) the attorney general's decision on the request. The database at a minimum must allow a person to search 11 (b) 12 for a request or decision described by Subsection (a) by: (1) the name of the governmental body making the 13 14 request; and 15 (2) the exception under Subchapter C that a governmental body asserts in the request applies to its request to 16 17 withhold information from public disclosure. (c) The database must allow a person to view the current 18 19 status of a request described by Subsection (a)(1) and an estimated timeline indicating the date each stage of review of the request 20 will be started and completed. 21 SECTION 3. Section 552.306, Government Code, as amended by 22 this Act, applies to a request for an attorney general decision made 23 24 under Subchapter G, Chapter 552, of that code on or after the

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25 effective date of this Act. A request for an attorney general 26 decision made before the effective date of this Act is governed by 27 the law in effect on the date the request was made, and the former

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1 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

2 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable, but not later than 3 January 1, 2024, the office of the attorney general shall make the 4 database required by Section 552.310, Government Code, as added by 5 this Act, available on the office's Internet website.

6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
