(a) 13 14 This subchapter does not prohibit, restrict, or limit the authority of an institution of higher education, other than a junior college 15 16 district, to offer a degree or certificate program in a service area designated in this subchapter. 17 (b) A junior college district may not object to the 18 implementation of a program or course offered by an institution of 19 higher education, other than an institution of higher education 20 that is another junior college district, solely on the basis that 21 the program or course is offered in the objecting junior college 22 23 district's service area. 24 (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may not

1 <u>approve or disapprove a new degree or certificate program, or the</u> 2 <u>continuation of an existing degree or certificate program, solely</u> 3 <u>on the basis that the program is offered or proposed to be offered</u> 4 <u>in a junior college district's service area. This subsection does</u> 5 <u>not apply to the approval or disapproval of a program offered or</u> 6 <u>proposed to be offered by a junior college district in the service</u> 7 <u>area of another junior college district.</u>

8 SECTION 3. Sections 135.04(b) and (c) and Section 9 135.102(c), Education Code, are repealed.

10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
