## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the taking of wildlife by an employee of the Parks and
- 3 Wildlife Department or by a person or agent of the person on the
- 4 person's property.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 12.013, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c), (d),
- 8 (e), and (f) to read as follows:
- 9 (a) An employee of the department acting within the scope of
- 10 the employee's authority may possess, take, transport, release, and
- 11 manage any of the wildlife and fish in this state for public safety,
- 12 investigation, propagation, distribution, education, disease
- 13 diagnosis or prevention, or scientific purposes.
- 14 (c) An employee of the department acting within the scope of
- 15 the employee's authority may discharge a firearm to take wildlife
- on a public road or right-of-way if the wildlife is:
- 17 <u>(1) mortally injured; or</u>
- 18 (2) behaving in a manner consistent with the wildlife
- 19 being diseased.
- 20 <u>(d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a person or agent</u>
- 21 of the person may take wildlife on the person's property if the
- 22 person:
- 23 (1) has written authorization from the department; and
- 24 (2) is participating under the supervision of a

- 1 department employee in a program or event designated by the
- 2 director as being conducted for the diagnosis, management, or
- 3 prevention of a disease in wildlife.
- 4 (e) Subsection (d) does not apply to a person or agent who is
- 5 a department employee.
- 6 (f) The commission may adopt rules to implement this
- 7 section.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 62.0031(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (b) This section does not apply to:
- 11 <u>(1)</u> the trapping of a raptor for educational or
- 12 sporting purposes as provided by Chapter 49; or
- 13 (2) an employee of the department taking wildlife as
- 14 provided by Section 12.013(c).
- SECTION 3. Section 42.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 16 Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 17 (e-1) Subsection (a)(9) does not apply to a person who, at
- 18 the time the person engaged in conduct prohibited under that
- 19 subdivision, was an employee of the Parks and Wildlife Department
- 20 acting within the scope of the employee's authority under Section
- 21 12.013(c), Parks and Wildlife Code.
- 22 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 25 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 26 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 27 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

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- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 2 before that date.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
