## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to prohibiting sex offenders from purchasing firearms.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 62, Code of Criminal

- Art. 62.066. PROHIBITED FIREARM PURCHASE. A person subject
- 7 to registration under this chapter may not purchase a firearm as
- 8 <u>defined by Section 46.01, Penal Code.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. Article 62.053(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, 10 is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Before a person who will be subject to registration
- 12 under this chapter is due to be released from a penal institution,
- 13 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or the Texas Juvenile
- 14 Justice Department shall determine the person's level of risk to
- 15 the community using the sex offender screening tool developed or
- 16 selected under Article 62.007 and assign to the person a numeric
- 17 risk level of one, two, or three. Before releasing the person, an
- 18 official of the penal institution shall:
- 19 (1) inform the person that:
- 20 (A) not later than the later of the seventh day
- 21 after the date on which the person is released or after the date on
- 22 which the person moves from a previous residence to a new residence
- 23 in this state or not later than the first date the applicable local
- 24 law enforcement authority by policy allows the person to register

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- 1 or verify registration, the person must register or verify
- 2 registration with the local law enforcement authority in the
- 3 municipality or county in which the person intends to reside;
- 4 (B) not later than the seventh day after the date
- 5 on which the person is released or the date on which the person

- 7 the person must, if the person has not moved to an intended
- 8 residence, report to the applicable entity or entities as required
- 9 by Article 62.051(h) or (j) or 62.055(e);
- 10 (C) not later than the seventh day before the
- 11 date on which the person moves to a new residence in this state or
- 12 another state, the person must report in person to the local law
- 13 enforcement authority designated as the person's primary
- 14 registration authority by the department and to the juvenile
- 15 probation officer, community supervision and corrections
- 16 department officer, or parole officer supervising the person;
- 17 (D) not later than the 10th day after the date on
- 18 which the person arrives in another state in which the person
- 19 intends to reside, the person must register with the law
- 20 enforcement agency that is identified by the department as the
- 21 agency designated by that state to receive registration
- 22 information, if the other state has a registration requirement for
- 23 sex offenders;
- (E) not later than the 30th day after the date on
- 25 which the person is released, the person must apply to the
- 26 department in person for the issuance of an original or renewal
- 27 driver's license or personal identification certificate and a

- 1 failure to apply to the department as required by this paragraph
- 2 results in the automatic revocation of any driver's license or
- 3 personal identification certificate issued by the department to the

- 5 (F) the person must notify appropriate entities
- 6 of any change in status as described by Article 62.057;
- 7 (G) certain types of employment are prohibited
- 8 under Article 62.063 for a person with a reportable conviction or
- 9 adjudication for a sexually violent offense involving a victim
- 10 younger than 14 years of age and occurring on or after September 1,
- 11 2013;
- 12 (H) certain locations of residence are
- 13 prohibited under Article 62.064 for a person with a reportable
- 14 conviction or adjudication for an offense occurring on or after
- 15 September 1, 2017, except as otherwise provided by that article;
- 16 [<del>and</del>]
- 17 (I) if the person enters the premises of a school
- 18 as described by Article 62.065 and is subject to the requirements of
- 19 that article, the person must immediately notify the administrative
- 20 office of the school of the person's presence and the person's
- 21 registration status under this chapter; and
- (J) a person with a reportable conviction or
- 23 adjudication for an offense occurring on or after September 1,
- 24 2023, may not purchase a firearm, as provided by Article 62.066;
- 25 (2) require the person to sign a written statement
- 26 that the person was informed of the person's duties as described by
- 27 Subdivision (1) or Subsection (g) or, if the person refuses to sign

- 1 the statement, certify that the person was so informed;
- 2 (3) obtain the address or, if applicable, a detailed
- 3 description of each geographical location where the person expects
- 4 to reside on the person's release and other registration
- 5 information, including a photograph and complete set of
- 6 fingerprints; and
- 7 (4) complete the registration form for the person.
- 8 SECTION 3. Article 62.058(g), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 9 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (g) A local law enforcement authority that provides to a
- 11 person a registration form for verification as required by this
- 12 chapter shall include with the form a statement describing the
- 13 prohibitions [prohibition] under Articles [Article] 62.064 and
- 14 62.066.
- 15 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act in adding
- 16 Article 62.066, Code of Criminal Procedure, applies only to a
- 17 person who is required to register under Chapter 62, Code of
- 18 Criminal Procedure, on the basis of a conviction or adjudication
- 19 for an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 22 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- (b) A person who is required to register under Chapter 62,
- 24 Code of Criminal Procedure, solely on the basis of a conviction or
- 25 adjudication that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 26 governed by the law in effect on the date the conviction or
- 27 adjudication occurred, and the former law is continued in effect

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- 1 for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
