4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 10, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 2155 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 2155. TEMPORARY PRESCRIBED BURN MANAGER SELF-INSURANCE
8	POOL
9	Sec. 2155.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Fund" means the prescribed burn manager
11	self-insurance fund established under Section 2155.006.
12	(2) "Prescribed burn manager" means a person who is a
13	certified and insured prescribed burn manager under Section
14	153.048, Natural Resources Code.

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- (3) "Program" means the prescribed burn manager 15
- self-insurance program administered under this chapter. 16
- 17 (4) "Service" means the Texas Forest Service of The
- Texas A&M University System. 18
- Sec. 2155.002. PRESCRIBED BURN MANAGER SELF-INSURANCE 19
- 20 PROGRAM. (a) The service shall administer a prescribed burn
- 21 manager self-insurance program that:
- (1) identifies and evaluates risks arising from 22
- prescribed burns conducted under Chapter 153, Natural Resources 23
- 24 Code;

Τ	(2) maintains a loss-prevention and loss-control
2	program to reduce risks arising from prescribed burns;
3	(3) consolidates and administers prescribed burn risk
4	management and self-insurance programs; and
5	(4) provides prescribed burn self-insurance coverage
6	in accordance with Section 2155.003.
7	(b) The service may employ staff to administer the program.
8	(c) The director of the service may adopt rules to implement
9	and administer the program.
10	Sec. 2155.003. SELF-INSURANCE POOL; COVERAGE. (a) The
11	program shall administer a self-insurance pool to provide general
12	liability coverage for prescribed burns a prescribed burn manager
13	conducts.
14	(b) The coverage may indemnify a participating prescribed
15	burn manager for liability arising from a prescribed burn conducted
16	by the manager. The coverage limits provided must be the minimum
17	amounts required for purposes of Section 153.082, Natural Resources
18	Code, or a lesser amount determined necessary based on the
19	liquidity of the fund after deducting the cost of administering
20	this chapter.
21	(c) The self-insurance pool may not provide coverage for a
22	risk other than a prescribed burn conducted by a participating
23	prescribed burn manager. Prohibited coverage includes:
24	<pre>(1) workers' compensation;</pre>
25	(2) automobile liability; and
26	(3) errors and omissions or professional liability.

(d) Self-insurance coverage provided under this section may

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- 1 be funded only from money available from the fund.
- 2 (e) The director of the service may establish:
- 3 (1) eligibility requirements for participation in
- 4 coverage under this section; and
- 5 (2) equipment and safety standards for the prescribed
- 6 burns to be covered under this section.
- 7 Sec. 2155.004. PARTICIPATION IN SELF-INSURANCE POOL. (a)
- 8 To participate in coverage provided under Section 2155.003, a
- 9 prescribed burn manager must submit a written request to the
- 10 program in the form and manner prescribed by the service.
- 11 (b) The director of the service shall approve the request
- 12 for participation if each proposed prescribed burn to be covered
- 13 meets the eligibility requirements and equipment and safety
- 14 standards established under Section 2155.003(e).
- Sec. 2155.005. TRAINING REQUIREMENTS. (a) As a condition
- 16 for continuing participation in coverage provided under Section
- 17 2155.003, a participating prescribed burn manager shall complete a
- 18 wildfire suppression course administered by the service that trains
- 19 the manager on:
- 20 (1) proper coordination with this state or local fire
- 21 departments in the event that a prescribed burn escapes its
- 22 <u>predetermined boundaries; and</u>
- 23 (2) proper assistance in the suppression of a
- 24 naturally occurring wildfire.
- 25 (b) The service shall:
- 26 (1) develop the course described by Subsection (a) in
- 27 compliance with National Wildfire Coordinating Group standards;

2	(2) maintain records of a participating burn manager's
3	completion of the course.
4	Sec. 2155.006. PRESCRIBED BURN MANAGER SELF-INSURANCE
5	FUND. (a) The fund is an account in a depository selected by the
6	board of regents of The Texas A&M University System in the manner
7	provided by Section 51.003, Education Code, for funds subject to
8	the control of institutions of higher education under Section
9	51.002, Education Code.
10	(b) The fund is composed of:
11	(1) an amount not to exceed \$25 million appropriated
12	by the legislature;
13	(2) money collected under Section 2155.008; and
14	(3) interest accruing on money in the fund.
15	(c) Money in the fund may be spent only for:
16	(1) funding self-insurance under the program; or
17	(2) administering this chapter, including paying the
18	salaries and expenses of staff for the program and the fund.
19	Sec. 2155.007. LIMITATION ON STATE'S LIABILITY. The
20	state's liability for a loss covered by self-insurance provided
21	under this chapter is limited to the assets of the fund, and the
22	state is not otherwise liable for that loss.
23	Sec. 2155.008. SELF-INSURANCE FEE; COST-SHARING
24	REQUIREMENTS. (a) The service may assess and collect a reasonable
25	fee from participating prescribed burn managers to provide
26	self-insurance coverage under this chapter. The service shall also
27	establish reasonable cost-sharing requirements, including

- 1 appropriate deductibles.
- 2 (b) In establishing the amount of the fee and the
- 3 cost-sharing requirements, the service shall consider the amount
- 4 that could be charged to the prescribed burn manager for similar
- 5 insurance coverage provided to that prescribed burn manager in
- 6 accordance with this code and ensure that a deductible is
- 7 sufficiently high to:
- 8 (1) deter the use of the self-insurance coverage for
- 9 minor losses; and
- 10 (2) ensure the self-insurance coverage is used only
- 11 for significant losses.
- 12 (c) The service shall adjust the amount of a premium for the
- 13 self-insurance coverage under this chapter by using the information
- 14 collected under Section 2155.009.
- 15 (d) Money collected under this section shall be deposited to
- 16 the credit of the fund.
- 17 Sec. 2155.009. PRESCRIBED BURN DATA COLLECTION. A
- 18 participating prescribed burn manager shall report in the form and
- 19 manner prescribed by the service the following information for each
- 20 prescribed burn the manager conducts:
- 21 (1) the amount of land burned in acres;
- 22 (2) the date of the burn; and
- 23 (3) whether the burn resulted in a financial loss or
- 24 wildfire response.
- Sec. 2155.010. EXCESSIVE CLAIMS. If the service determines
- 26 that a participating prescribed burn manager has made excessive
- 27 claims under self-insurance coverage under this chapter, the

- 1 service may:
- 2 (1) terminate the manager's participation in the
- 3 self-insurance pool under this chapter; and
- 4 (2) refer the manager to the prescribed burn board for
- 5 disciplinary action under Section 153.102, Natural Resources Code,
- 6 as if the manager violated Chapter 153 of that code.
- 7 Sec. 2155.011. LEGAL REPRESENTATION. (a) The service may
- 8 employ an attorney to represent a prescribed burn manager in a
- 9 liability action for which insurance coverage is provided under
- 10 this chapter.
- 11 (b) The attorney general may not provide the services
- 12 described by Subsection (a).
- 13 Sec. 2155.012. EXPIRATION OF PROGRAM AND CHAPTER. The
- 14 program and this chapter expire September 1, 2038. On expiration of
- 15 the program, the remaining balance in the fund that is not needed to
- 16 pay claims is transferred to the statewide fire contingency account
- 17 established under Section 88.117, Education Code.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
