1-19 relating to designating October as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness  
 1-20 Month.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is  
 1-23 amended by adding Section 662.116 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 662.116. FENTANYL POISONING AWARENESS MONTH. (a)  
 1-25 October is Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month to increase awareness  
 1-26 of the dangers of fentanyl and potential overdoses.

1-27 (b) Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month may be regularly  
 1-28 observed through appropriate activities in communities to increase  
 1-29 awareness of the dangers of fentanyl and potential overdoses.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
