A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the identification of the country of manufacture on the
3	label for a prescription drug or biological product.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 562.006, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as
7	follows:
8	(a-1) The label on the dispensing container on a drug or
9	biological product dispensed by a pharmacy must indicate the
10	country where the drug or biological product was manufactured.
11	(b) In addition to the information required by Subsections
12	[Subsection] (a) and (a-1), the label on the dispensing container
13	of a drug or biological product dispensed by a Class A or Class E
14	pharmacy must indicate:
15	(1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
16	pharmacy;
17	(2) the date the prescription is dispensed;
18	(3) the name of the prescribing practitioner;
19	(4) the name of the patient or, if the drug or
20	biological product was prescribed for an animal, the species of the
21	animal and the name of the owner;
22	(5) instructions for use;

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(7) if the drug or biological product is dispensed in a

(6) the quantity dispensed;

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- 1 container other than the manufacturer's original container, the
- 2 date after which the prescription should not be used, determined
- 3 according to criteria established by board rule based on standards
- 4 in the United States Pharmacopeia-National Formulary; and
- 5 (8) any other information required by board rule.
- 6 SECTION 2. The Texas State Board of Pharmacy shall adopt any
- 7 rules necessary to implement Section 562.006(a-1), Occupations
- 8 Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2024.
- 9 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 10 to a drug or biological product dispensed on or after March 1, 2024.
- 11 A drug or biological product dispensed before March 1, 2024, is
- 12 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 13 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 14 purpose.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
