The changes in law made this Act do not apply to 18 property that is, as of the effective date of this Act, subject to a 19 voluntary bankruptcy proceeding or to a valid claim of a holder of a 20 21 final judgment who has, by levy, garnishment, or other legal process, obtained rights superior to those that would otherwise be 22 23 held by a trustee in bankruptcy if a bankruptcy petition were then 24 pending against the debtor. That property is subject to the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 25
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
