7	(d) The agency shall provide equivalent access to the
8	registry maintained under this section to:
9	(1) private schools;
10	(2) public schools; [and]
11	(3) child-care facilities and family homes licensed,

- 12 registered, or listed under Chapter 42, Human Resources Code; and
- 13 <u>(4)</u> nonprofit teacher organizations approved by the 14 commissioner for the purpose of participating in the tutoring 15 program established under Section 33.913.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
