4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 156.001, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
7	(d-1) If the license holder supervises or delegates medical
8	acts to any non-physician health care provider, the license holder
9	shall attest on the registration renewal application that the
10	license holder has provided proper supervision and has properly
11	delegated medical acts:
12	(1) generally, for any non-physician health care
13	provider; and
14	(2) specifically, for any advanced practice
15	registered nurse or physician assistant with whom the license
16	holder has entered into a prescriptive authority agreement under
17	Section 157.0512.
18	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas
19	Medical Board by rule shall prescribe the method by which a
20	physician who renews the physician's registration permit may make
21	and electronically sign the attestation required by Section
22	156.001(d-1), Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
23	SECTION 3. Section 156.001(d-1), Occupations Code, as added
24	by this Act, applies only to an application for renewal of a

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registration permit submitted on or after January 1, 2024.
SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
