    amended by adding Section 37.116 to read as follows:

          Sec. 37.116. EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING. (a) A school
23

   district shall require each principal, assistant principal, school
   marshal, school district peace officer, school resource officer,
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and school security personnel employed by or assigned to the

district to complete the following emergency response management

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- 1 training courses provided by the Federal Emergency Management
- 2 Agency:
- 3 (1) Introduction to the Incident Command System;
- 4 (2) Basic Incident Command System for Initial
- 5 Response;
- 6 (3) An Introduction to the National Incident
- 7 Management System; and
- 8 (4) National Response Framework, An Introduction.
- 9 (b) The board of trustees of a school district shall adopt
- 10 policies to:
- 11 (1) verify completion of the training by each person
- 12 required to complete the training under Subsection (a); and
- 13 (2) provide annual emergency response management
- 14 training exercises incorporating the training required under
- 15 Subsection (a).
- SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 17 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,
- 18 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 19 codes.
- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
