- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 824.602(a), Government Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Subject to Section 825.506, the retirement system may
- 9 not, under Section 824.601, withhold a monthly benefit payment if
- 10 the retiree is employed in a Texas public educational institution:
- 11 (1) as a substitute only with pay not more than the
- 12 daily rate of substitute pay established by the employer and, if the
- 13 retiree is a disability retiree, the employment has not exceeded a
- 14 total of 90 days in the school year;
- 15 (2) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
- 16 more than a one-half time basis for the month;
- 17 (3) in one or more positions on as much as a full-time
- 18 basis, if the retiree has been separated from service with all Texas
- 19 public educational institutions for at least 12 full consecutive
- 20 months after the retiree's effective date of retirement;
- 21 (4) in a position, other than as a substitute, on no
- 22 more than a one-half time basis for no more than 90 days in the
- 23 school year, if the retiree is a disability retiree; [or]
- 24 (5) as a tutor under Section 33.913, Education Code;

- 1 <u>or</u>
- 2 (6) in a position in an area subject to a declaration
- 3 of disaster by the governor under Chapter 418 or a declaration of
- 4 local disaster under that chapter while the declaration is in
- 5 effect.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 824.602, Government Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act, applies only to the employment of a retiree of the Teacher
- 8 Retirement System of Texas on or after the effective date of this
- 9 Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 11 of this Act, the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall adopt
- 12 rules as necessary to implement Section 824.602, Government Code,
- 13 as amended by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
