2	relating to the inclusion of firearm safety instruction in the

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (u) to read as follows:
7	(u) In addition to any other essential knowledge and skills
8	the State Board of Education adopts for the health curriculum under
9	Subsection (a)(2)(B), the board shall adopt for the health
10	curriculum essential knowledge and skills that address topics
11	relating to firearm safety that:
12	(1) focus on accident prevention;
13	(2) promote the safety and protection of students; and
14	(3) emphasize how students should respond when
15	encountering a firearm.
16	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
17	school year.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22	Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
