4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 533, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER C. PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS UNDER CERTAIN OUTPATIENT
8	PHARMACY BENEFIT PLANS
9	Sec. 533.071. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter

- applies only to an outpatient pharmacy benefit plan implemented by 10
- 11 a Medicaid managed care organization.
- 12 Sec. 533.072. PREFERRED DRUG LIST EXCEPTIONS.
- Notwithstanding any other law, a Medicaid managed care organization 13
- 14 is not required to adhere to the preferred drug list adopted by the
- commission under Section 531.072 and shall grant an exception to 15
- 16 the list with respect to a recipient if:
- 17 (1) the preferred drug:
- 18 (A) is contraindicated;
- 19 (B) will likely cause an adverse reaction in or
- physical or mental harm to the recipient; or 20
- 21 (C) is expected to be ineffective based on the
- 22 known clinical characteristics of the recipient and the known
- 23 characteristics of the prescription drug regimen;
- 24 (2) the recipient previously discontinued taking the

1	preferred drug at any point in the recipient's clinical history and
2	for any length of time because the drug:
3	(A) was not effective;
4	(B) had a diminished effect; or
5	(C) resulted in an adverse event;
6	(3) the preferred drug is not in the best interest of
7	the recipient, based on clinical appropriateness, because the
8	recipient's use of the drug is expected to cause a significant
9	barrier to the recipient's adherence to or compliance with the
10	recipient's plan of care;
11	(4) the recipient was prescribed and is taking a
12	nonpreferred drug in the antidepressant or antipsychotic drug class
13	and the recipient:
14	(A) was prescribed the nonpreferred drug before
15	being discharged from an inpatient facility;
16	(B) is stable on the nonpreferred drug; and
17	(C) is at risk of experiencing complications from
18	switching from the nonpreferred drug to another drug;
19	(5) the preferred drug is not available for reasons
20	outside of the Medicaid managed care organization's control,
21	<pre>including because:</pre>
22	(A) the drug is in short supply according to the
23	Food and Drug Administration Drug Shortages Database; or
24	(B) the drug's manufacturer has placed the drug
25	on backorder or allocation; or
26	(6) the preferred drug is not available at a pharmacy
27	located within a 10-mile radius of the recipient.

- 1 Sec. 533.073. PREFERRED DRUG LIST; SEARCHABLE DATABASE OF
- 2 PREFERRED DRUGS AND RESTRICTIONS. The commission shall ensure
- 3 that:
- 4 (1) an Internet-based, searchable database is made
- 5 available through which a provider may search the applicable
- 6 preferred drug list adopted by the commission under Section 531.072
- 7 to easily determine whether a prescription drug or drug class is
- 8 subject to any prior authorization requirements, clinical edits, or
- 9 other clinical restrictions; and
- 10 (2) reasonable efforts are made to ensure the database
- 11 contains current information.
- 12 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 13 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 14 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 15 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 16 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 17 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
