AN ACT

2 relating to the next generation 9-1-1 service fund. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 771.0713, Health and Safety Code, is 4 5 amended by amending Subsections (b), (f), and (g) and adding Subsections (c-1), (c-2), and (c-3) to read as follows: 6 7 (b) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by federal law, the comptroller shall transfer to the credit of the 8 next generation 9-1-1 service fund any amount available from 9 federal money provided to this state from the Coronavirus State and 10 11 Local Fiscal Recovery Funds under Section 9901 of the American 12 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Pub. L. No. 117-2) or from any other state or federal governmental source for purposes of this chapter, 13 14 including money appropriated or otherwise credited to the fund. The comptroller shall transfer the money as soon as practicable 15 16 following: (1) the receipt by this state of a sufficient amount of 17 federal money for the transfer; or 18 (2) the effective date of the most recent legislative 19 appropriation for purposes of this chapter. 20 21 (c-1) Except as provided by Subsection (c-2), the commission shall distribute from money appropriated to the 22 23 commission for purposes of this chapter to each emergency

24 communications district that does not participate in the state

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1	system a portion of the appropriated money in an amount
2	proportional to the population of the area served by the district
3	compared to the population of this state.
4	(c-2) For each emergency communication district created
5	under Chapter 772 that is entitled to a portion of the money
6	distributed under Subsection (c-1), the commission shall:

8	entitled by an amount equal to nine percent of that portion and
9	distribute that resulting amount in equal shares to all the
10	emergency communication districts created under Chapter 772; and

14	(c-3) The remaining money appropriated to the commission
15	for purposes of this chapter that is not otherwise distributed

18	(f) All money in the fund <u>from the Coronavirus State and</u>
19	Local Fiscal Recovery Funds under Section 9901 of the American

The changes in law made by this Act apply 12 beginning with the state fiscal biennium that begins September 1, 13 2023. 14 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
