- 8 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 9 (b) On the 60th day after the effective date of this Act:
- 10 (1) the Green Tree Park Municipal Utility District is

- 12 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire.
- SECTION 2. Effective on the 61st day after the effective
- 14 date of this Act, Chapter 7889, Special District Local Laws Code, is

- 16 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 17 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 18 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 19 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 20 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 21 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 22 Government Code.
- 23 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 24 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on

- 1 Environmental Quality.
- 2 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 3 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 4 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 5 representatives within the required time.
- 6 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 9 and accomplished.
- 10 SECTION 4. Except as provided by Section 2 of this Act, this
- 11 Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of
- 12 all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39,
- 13 Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the
- 14 vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect
- 15 September 1, 2023.
