## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the process of selecting member representatives for the
- 3 board of directions of the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2210.102, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 repeal Subsection (f) as follows:
- 7 COMPOSITION. (a) The board of directors is composed of nine
- 8 members appointed by the commissioner in accordance with this
- 9 section.
- 10 (b) Three members must be representatives of the insurance
- 11 industry who actively write and renew windstorm and hail insurance
- 12 in the first tier coastal counties.
- 13 (c) Three members must, as of the date of the appointment,
- 14 reside in the first tier coastal counties. Each of the following
- 15 regions must be represented by a member residing in the region and
- 16 appointed under this subsection:
- 17 (1) the region consisting of Cameron, Kenedy, Kleberg,
- 18 and Willacy Counties;
- 19 (2) the region consisting of Aransas, Calhoun, Nueces,
- 20 Refugio, and San Patricio Counties; and
- 21 (3) the region consisting of Brazoria, Chambers,
- 22 Galveston, Jefferson, and Matagorda Counties and any part of Harris
- 23 County designated as a catastrophe area under Section 2210.005.
- 24 (c-1) One of the members appointed under Subsection (c) must

- 1 be a property and casualty agent who is licensed under this code and
- 2 is not a captive agent.
- 3 (d) Three members must reside in an area of this state that
- 4 is located more than 100 miles from the Texas coastline.
- 5 (e) All members must have demonstrated experience in
- 6 insurance, general business, or actuarial principles and the
- 7 member's area of expertise, if any, sufficient to make the success
- 8 of the association probable.
- 9 (f) Insurers who are members of the association shall
- 10 nominate, from among those members, persons to fill any vacancy in
- 11 the three board of director seats reserved for representatives of
- 12 the insurance industry. The board of directors shall solicit
- 13 nominations from the members and submit the nominations to the
- 14 commissioner. The nominee slate submitted to the commissioner under
- 15 this subsection must include at least three more names than the
- 16 number of vacancies. The commissioner may appoint replacement
- 17 insurance industry representatives from the nominee slate.
- 18 (g) (f) Members appointed to the board of directors under
- 19 Subsections (c) and (d), other than the member appointed under
- 20 Subsection (c-1), must represent the general public in the regions
- 21 described by those subsections. A person may not be appointed to
- 22 represent the general public under Subsection (c) or (d) if the
- 23 person or the person's spouse:
- 24 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 25 of a business entity or other organization:
- 26 (A) operating in the property and casualty
- 27 insurance industry in this state;

- 1 (B) receiving money from the association, other
- 2 than insurance claim payments; or
- 3 (C) receiving money from association
- 4 policyholders with respect to the policyholders' claims;
- 5 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 6 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 7 organization:
- 8 (A) operating in the property and casualty
- 9 insurance industry in this state;
- 10 (B) receiving money from the association, other
- 11 than insurance claim payments; or
- 12 (C) receiving money from association
- 13 policyholders with respect to the policyholders' claims; or
- 14 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 15 goods, services, or money from the association, other than:
- 16 (A) insurance claim payments; or
- 17 (B) compensation or reimbursement authorized by
- 18 law for the board members' membership, attendance, or expenses.
