A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the composition of the port commission of the Port of
- 3 Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5016.0051, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5016.0051. COMPOSITION OF PORT COMMISSION. The port
- 8 commission is composed of $\underline{\text{nine}}$ [seven] port commissioners.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 5016.0052(a), Special District Local
- 10 Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) Port commissioners are appointed as follows:
- 12 (1) the Commissioners Court of Nueces County shall
- 13 appoint three port commissioners;
- 14 (2) the city council of the City of Corpus Christi
- 15 shall appoint three port commissioners; and
- 16 (3) the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County
- 17 shall appoint three [one] port commissioners [commissioner].
- 18 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2024, the
- 19 Commissioners Court of San Patricio County shall appoint two port
- 20 commissioners to the port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi
- 21 Authority of Nueces County, Texas, as provided by Section
- 22 5016.0052(a), Special District Local Laws Code, as amended by this
- 23 Act, to serve terms that expire on dates that preserve the required
- 24 staggering of terms.

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- 1 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 2 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 3 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 4 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 5 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 6 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 7 Government Code.
- 8 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 9 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 10 Environmental Quality.
- 11 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 12 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 13 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 14 representatives within the required time.
- 15 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 16 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 17 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 18 and accomplished.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
