The port 7 commission is composed of <u>nine</u> [seven] port commissioners. 8 SECTION 2. Section 5016.0052(a), Special District Local 9 Laws Code, is amended to read as follows: 10 11 (a) Port commissioners are appointed as follows: 12 (1) the Commissioners Court of Nueces County shall 13 appoint three port commissioners; 14 (2) the city council of the City of Corpus Christi shall appoint three port commissioners; and 15 (3) the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County 16 17 shall appoint three [one] port commissioners, two of whom serve as non-voting commissioners in an advisory capacity only 18 [commissioner]. 19 20 SECTION 3. Not later than one year after the effective date of this Act, the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County shall 21 appoint two port commissioners to the port commission of the Port of 22 23 Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas, as provided by Section 5016.0052(a), Special District Local Laws Code, as amended 24

1 by this Act, to serve terms that expire on dates that preserve the 2 required staggering of terms.

3 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 4 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 5 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 6 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 7 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 8 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 9 Government Code.

10 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 11 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 12 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 13 (C) 14 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 15 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within the required time. 16

17 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 18 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 19 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 20 and accomplished.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
