- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 304.003, Estates Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 304.003. PERSONS DISQUALIFIED TO SERVE AS EXECUTOR OR
- 8 ADMINISTRATOR. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a [A]
- 9 person is not qualified to serve as an executor or administrator if
- 10 the person is:
- 11 (1) incapacitated;
- 12 (2) a felon convicted under the laws of the United
- 13 States or of any state of the United States unless, in accordance
- 14 with law, the person has been pardoned or has had the person's civil
- 15 rights restored;
- 16 (3) a nonresident of this state who:
- 17 (A) is a natural person or corporation; and
- 18 (B) has not:
- 19 (i) appointed a resident agent to accept
- 20 service of process in all actions or proceedings with respect to the
- 21 estate; or
- (ii) had that appointment filed with the
- 23 court;
- 24 (4) a corporation not authorized to act as a fiduciary

- 1 in this state; or
- 2 (5) a person whom the court finds unsuitable.
- 3 (b) A person described by Subsection (a)(2) is not
- 4 <u>disqualified from serving as an executor of a decedent's estate</u>
- 5 under Subsection (a)(2) if:
- 6 (1) the person is named as executor in the decedent's
- 7 <u>will;</u>
- 8 (2) the person is otherwise qualified to serve as an
- 9 executor; and
- 10 (3) the court approves the person serving as an
- 11 <u>executor</u>.
- 12 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 13 304.003, Estates Code, apply only to the estate of a decedent who
- 14 dies on or after the effective date of this Act. The estate of a
- 15 decedent who dies before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 16 by the law in effect on the date of the decedent's death, and the
- 17 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
