BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 401.026, Labor Code, is amended to read 7 as follows:

8 Sec. 401.026. APPLICABILITY TO CERTAIN EMERGENCY RESPONSE 9 PERSONNEL. For purposes of this subtitle, the travel of a 10 firefighter, peace officer, or emergency medical personnel en route 11 to an emergency call is considered to be in the course and scope of 12 the firefighter's, peace officer's, or emergency medical 13 personnel's employment.

14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a 16 compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of 17 this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before 18 that date is governed by the law as it existed on the date the 19 compensable injury occurred, and the former law is continued in 20 effect for that purpose.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
