1-27 relating to the amount of the fee imposed on certain sexually
 1-28 oriented businesses that is allocated to the sexual assault program
 1-29 fund and the allocation of certain other revenue to that fund;
 1-30 increasing the amount of a fee.

1-31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-32 SECTION 1. Section 102.052(a), Business & Commerce Code, is
 1-33 amended to read as follows:

1-34 (a) A fee is imposed on a sexually oriented business in an
 1-35 amount equal to \$10 [~~\$5~~] for each entry by each customer admitted to
 1-36 the business.

1-37 SECTION 2. Section 420.008(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-38 to read as follows:

1-39 (b) The fund consists of:

1-40 (1) fees and fines collected under:

1-41 (A) Article 42A.653(a), Code of Criminal
 1-42 Procedure;

1-43 (B) Section 508.189, Government Code; and

1-44 (C) Subchapter B, Chapter 102, Business &
 1-45 Commerce Code, and deposited under Section 102.054 of that code;

1-47 (2) administrative penalties collected under Section
 1-48 51.258, Education Code; and

1-49 (3) amounts allocated under Section 183.054, Tax Code.

1-50 SECTION 3. Section 183.023(b), Tax Code, is amended to read
 1-51 as follows:

1-52 (b) Except for the amounts allocated under Subsection (c) of
 1-53 this section or Subchapter C of this chapter, the comptroller shall
 1-54 deposit the revenue received under this section in the general
 1-55 revenue fund.

1-56 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 183, Tax Code, is amended
 1-57 by adding Section 183.054 to read as follows:

1-58 Sec. 183.054. ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN REVENUE TO SEXUAL
 1-59 ASSAULT PROGRAM FUND. The comptroller shall deposit an amount of
 1-60 money equal to one percent of the revenue received under
 1-61 Subchapters B and B-1 to the credit of the sexual assault program

2-1 fund established under Section 420.008, Government Code.

2-2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
