A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to active shooter training for peace officers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended

5 by adding Subsection (q) to read as follows:

- 6 (q) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the
- 7 <u>commission shall require an officer to complete a training program</u>
- 8 of not less than 16 hours on responding to an active shooter as
- 9 developed by the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training
- 10 <u>Center at Texas State University--San Marcos. An officer shall</u>
- 11 complete the program not later than the last day of the first full
- 12 continuing education training period that begins on or after the
- 13 date the officer is licensed under this chapter unless the officer
- 14 completes the program as part of the officer's basic training
- 15 course. Completion of a training program under this subsection
- 16 satisfies any other requirement, other than a continuing education
- 17 requirement under Section 1701.3525, for the officer to complete a
- 18 training program on responding to active shootings, including under
- 19 Section 37.0812(a), Education Code.
- 20 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 1701.3525 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1701.3525. ACTIVE SHOOTER RESPONSE TRAINING REQUIRED
- 23 FOR OFFICERS. (a) As part of the continuing education programs
- 24 under Section 1701.351(a), an officer must complete not less than

- 1 16 hours of training on responding to an active shooter as developed
- 2 by the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training Center at
- 3 Texas State University--San Marcos.
- 4 (b) The exemptions under Sections 1701.351(b), (c), and (d)
- 5 do not apply to the training required by Subsection (a).
- 6 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 7 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall adopt
- 8 rules to implement Sections 1701.253(q) and 1701.3525, Occupations
- 9 Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. The minimum curriculum requirements under
- 11 Section 1701.253(q), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, apply
- 12 only to an officer who first begins to satisfy those requirements on
- 13 or after January 1, 2024.
- SECTION 5. Section 1701.3525, Occupations Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies only with respect to a 24-month continuing
- 16 education training unit that begins on or after the effective date
- 17 of this Act. A training unit that begins before the effective date
- 18 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the training
- 19 unit began, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
