- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 54, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 54.6585 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.6585. CLERK. (a) The district clerk serves as
- 8 clerk of the cases referred to a magistrate under this subchapter,
- 9 except:
- 10 (1) the county clerk serves as clerk for a Class A or
- 11 Class B misdemeanor case filed in a county criminal court and
- 12 referred to a magistrate; and
- 13 (2) the originating justice court clerk serves as
- 14 clerk for a Class C misdemeanor case filed in a justice court and
- 15 referred to a magistrate.
- 16 (b) The district clerk shall establish a docket and keep the
- 17 minutes for the cases referred to a magistrate under this
- 18 <u>subchapter</u>. The local administrative judge shall ensure the duties
- 19 required under this subsection are performed. To facilitate the
- 20 duties associated with serving as the clerk for the cases referred
- 21 to a magistrate, the district clerk and deputy district clerks may
- 22 serve as deputy county clerks and deputy justice clerks at the
- 23 discretion of the district clerk.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
