A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the disposition of certain property by the former Bois
- 3 D'Arc Island Levee Improvement District of Dallas and Kaufman
- 4 Counties and the record of dissolution of that district.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) In this section:
- 7 (1) "After-discovered property" means property or
- 8 assets of the district that were not sold, transferred, or disposed
- 9 of under Section 7801.003, Special District Local Laws Code, or
- 10 were assigned to the district after the dissolution of the district
- 11 under that section.
- 12 (2) "District" means the former Bois D'Arc Island
- 13 Levee Improvement District of Dallas and Kaufman Counties.
- 14 (b) The commissioners courts of Dallas County and Kaufman
- 15 County shall issue a joint order appointing a trustee or receiver to
- 16 dispose of after-discovered property. The commissioners courts may
- 17 appoint the trustee or receiver with or without a bond or payment.
- 18 (c) The trustee or receiver appointed under Subsection (b)
- 19 of this section must:
- 20 (1) dispose of any after-discovered property in
- 21 accordance with state law that provides for the disposition or
- 22 disposal of property by a county; and
- 23 (2) receive approval from the commissioners courts of
- 24 Dallas County and Kaufman County before disposing of any property.

- 1 (d) Money made from the sale or disposition of
- 2 after-discovered property under this section must be used to pay
- 3 any liability, debt, contract, or other obligation of the district,
- 4 including any liability, debt, contract, or other obligation
- 5 incurred in the appointment of the trustee or receiver or the
- 6 execution of the duties of the trustee or receiver. Any remaining
- 7 money must be distributed equally between Dallas County and Kaufman
- 8 County.
- 9 (e) The assets of Dallas County and Kaufman County,
- 10 including tax revenue funds:
- 11 (1) may not be used by the district to pay any
- 12 liability, debt, contract, or other obligation of the district; and
- 13 (2) are not subject to any liability, debt, contract,
- 14 or other obligation of the district.
- 15 (f) Nothing in this section may be construed to constitute a
- 16 waiver of the immunity or defenses of Dallas County, Kaufman
- 17 County, or the officials, officers, employees, and agents of the
- 18 counties regarding a suit or liability concerning the
- 19 after-discovered property.
- 20 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- 21 shall note in its records that the district has been dissolved.
- SECTION 3. Effective January 1, 2026, Chapter 7801, Special
- 23 District Local Laws Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
