- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 154.051, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) The Court Reporters Certification Advisory Board is
- 9 established as an advisory board to the commission. The advisory
- 10 board is composed of at least nine [seven] members appointed by the
- 11 supreme court as follows:
- 12 (1) one active district judge presiding over a court
- 13 that employs an official court reporter;
- 14 (2) one active attorney licensed in this state who has
- 15 been a practicing member of the State Bar for more than the five
- 16 years immediately preceding the attorney's appointment to the
- 17 advisory board;
- 18 (3) two <u>certified shorthand</u> [active official court]
- 19 reporters actively engaged in the practice of official court [who
- 20 have practiced shorthand] reporting in this state for more than the
- 21 five years immediately preceding their appointment to the advisory
- 22 board;
- 23 (4) two [active] certified shorthand reporters
- 24 actively engaged in the practice of [who work on a freelance basis

- 1 and who have practiced] shorthand reporting on a freelance basis
- 2 for more than the five years immediately preceding their
- 3 appointment to the advisory board; [and]
- 4 (5) one certified shorthand reporter actively engaged
- 5 in practice as a captioner in this state for more than the five
- 6 years immediately preceding the captioner's appointment to the
- 7 <u>advisory board; and</u>
- 8 (6) two certified shorthand reporters who:
- 9 (A) own a shorthand reporting firm in this state;
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (B) have owned and [one representative of a
- 12 shorthand reporting firm that has] operated [as] a shorthand
- 13 reporting firm in this state for more than the five [three] years
- 14 immediately preceding their [the representative's] appointment to
- 15 the advisory board.
- 16 (f-1) Not later than the 90th day before the expiration of
- 17 an advisory board member's term, the commission:
- 18 (1) shall post on the commission's Internet website
- 19 notice of the availability of the membership position;
- 20 (2) shall accept resumes from and conduct interviews
- 21 of any qualified individuals interested in appointment to the
- 22 position; and
- 23 (3) may recommend to the supreme court one or more of
- 24 the qualified individuals for appointment to the advisory board.
- 25 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 26 date of this Act, the Texas Supreme Court shall appoint two
- 27 additional members of the Court Reporters Certification Advisory

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- 1 Board in accordance with Section 154.051(a), Government Code, as
- 2 amended by this Act.
