7	Sec. 531.024142. DIAPER DISTRIBUTION GRANT PROGRAM. (a)
8	In this section, "nonprofit organization" means an organization
9	that is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a),
10	Internal Revenue Code of 1986, by being listed as an exempt entity
11	under Section 501(c)(3) of that code.
12	(b) The commission shall establish and administer a program
13	through which the commission, using money appropriated or otherwise
14	available for that purpose, may award a grant to nonprofit
15	organizations that collect, store, and distribute diapers to
16	families to enable the nonprofit organizations to develop new
17	infrastructure and expand services to more families in the state.
18	(c) To be considered for a grant under this section, a
19	nonprofit organization must:
20	(1) have experience distributing a large number of
21	diapers to families in this state;
22	(2) have sufficient warehouse space to store at least

(3) work with at least 25 entities in the target

- 1 community to distribute diapers;
- 2 (4) demonstrate an ability to expand the
- 3 <u>organization's distribution; and</u>
- 4 (5) have sufficient personnel available to distribute
- 5 <u>at least one million diapers in this state in a year.</u>
- 6 (d) The commission shall establish:
- 7 (1) grant application procedures; and
- 8 (2) procedures for monitoring the use of a grant
- 9 awarded under the program and ensuring compliance with any
- 10 condition of a grant.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
