1-19 relating to the authority of a municipality to annex property in
 1-20 certain water districts.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 43.071(e), Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e) Subsections (b)-(d) do not apply to the annexation of:

1-25 (1) an area within a water or sewer district if:

1-26 (A) the governing body of the district consents
 1-27 to the annexation;

1-28 (B) the owners in fee simple of the area to be
 1-29 annexed consent to the annexation; and

1-30 (C) the annexed area does not exceed 525 feet in
 1-31 width at its widest point;

1-32 (2) a water or sewer district that has a noncontiguous
 1-33 part that is not within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the
 1-34 municipality; ~~or~~

1-35 (3) a part of a special utility district created or
 1-36 operating under Chapter 65, Water Code; or

1-37 (4) a property by a municipality with a population of
 1-38 less than 3,000 if the governing body of a water or sewer district
 1-39 the boundaries of which include the property consents to the
 1-40 annexation.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
